On my last financial report dated September 6 2008, the treasury had a balance of \$1239.91. From September 7th, 2008 through March 1st 2009, we have had an income of \$500.00, all from dues. Expenses for this period total \$168.41, and include \$154.35 for our website, and \$14.06 for paypal fees. That gives us a net gain of \$331.59 and a balance as of March 1st 2008 of \$ 1571.50. This includes \$5.00 that is in our old account at the Navy Credit Union. It does not include any amounts that are in the Ships Store account.
