Final Farewell

Captain Frank Richard Whalen, who served as Commanding Officer of Thomas C. Hart from 1983-1985 passed away on August 13, 2019. An email received from his son, Capt. Todd Whalen, read in part: "It is with great sadness that I inform you of my father's passing earlier this week after a long fight with cancer. As you know, he was a great man with a passion for living life at full speed ahead. He took great joy in serving others during his 30 years of naval service and 26 years of work with the Hampton Roads soccer community (his "retirement" gig). ...Dad was more of a 1MC kind of guy, so forgive me for using what amounts to DC message blanks to make reports. (Sorry, couldn't resist, Dad would have appreciated some navy humor.) Please feel free to forward to any '63 classmates or other shipmates I may have missed – I appreciate your help in spreading the word. ...join us in wishing an Old Salt fair winds and following seas."

A visitation was held in September at Holloman-Brown Funeral Home, Great Neck Chapel. Guests were encouraged to wear their favorite jersey/sand soccer/beach t-shirt, shorts, and sandals in true Dick Whalen style. Captain Whalen was laid to rest at the Albert G. Horton Jr. Memorial Veterans Cemetery in Suffolk, VA. Dick's family suggests observing evening colors at sunset or attending a youth soccer game (and cheering with enthusiasm) as a fitting tribute to his memory.

REUNION 2021

Our hotel is the Westin Washington Dulles Airport, 2520 Wasser Terrace, Herndon, VA 20171, (703) 793-3366. Although the official dates of the reunion are June 22-June 27th (Tues-Sunday morning), I strongly suggest you plan to stay a few extra days. Why? Because there is so much to do in the DC area that we can't possibly squeeze it all into four or five days. In downtown DC you have the Smithsonian Museums (Natural History, American History, American Art, African American Museum, Air and Space Museum and more), the Holocaust museum, the National Gallery of Art, the White House, the Capitol, the Supreme Court, monuments and memorials (Washington, Jefferson, Lincoln, Roosevelt, Vietnam, World War II, Navy Memorial, etc.). There's also Arlington National Cemetery. Want to see Pandas? Head for the National Zoo (free admission!)

Are you interested in genealogy? Plan on going to the National Archives, Library of Congress, or Daughters of the American Revolution Library. (I had a genealogical research business when I lived near DC a number of years ago. If you are interested in genealogy, please let me know and I can give you some suggestions.)

Up for some day trips? Within one hour of our hotel: Mount Vernon, Quantico, Harper's Ferry, and parts of the Skyline Drive. Within two hours: Annapolis (see the baby ring-knockers!), Gettysburg, Antietam battlefield, Baltimore and Fort McHenry (Oh say, can you see...).

Although driving and parking in DC can be a real pain, they have an excellent subway system to help you get around. Most of the museums and other attractions are free.

We haven't yet determined exactly which attractions we'll see during our reunion. Right now some leading candidates are the Navy Memorial (where we should be able to see our plaque), Arlington National Cemetery (where we should be able to pay our respects to Capt. MacMichael), and a general tour of the monuments downtown. The National Museum of the Marine Corps at Quantico, Mount Vernon, and the White House also have some strong proponents. What would you like to see included? Pass your suggestions on to Mark Lamboni, me, or any of our officers. We'll do our best to create a memorable reunion tour package.

CRUISE BOOKS

I have obtained reproductions of the 1983 and 1986 Med deployment cruise books and the 1990-91 Desert Storm cruise book. Along with the 1975 Med and 1976 Unitas cruise books, they will be provided on the free CDs distributed to shipmates at the 2021 reunion. The reproduction cruise books along with a separate CD of each will be raffled off at the next reunion.

These high quality reproductions were obtained from DBA Classic Cruise Book Reproductions <u>www.navycruisebooks.net</u> Although the only Hart cruisebooks in their inventory are the 75-76-83-86-91 books, they have a large inventory from other ships. The reproductions (which include a "hard copy" and a CD) run about \$50 each, depending on the size of the book and the type cover requested. I was able to work out a credit by letting them copy the 75 and 76 books, which they did not have in their inventory. You may be able to work out a similar deal if you have books they need. I was very pleased with the speed and quality of their service.

Are there Thomas C. Hart cruise books from other years? Please let me (Dave Neimeyer) know. It would be great to collect a complete set, or at least to know which years we are missing.
