February 25th 2012, Financial Report Thomas C. Hart Veterans Association

The last financial report was dated September 30th 2009 and was presented to the membership in the October Newsletter. At that time the ships treasury had a balance of \$3032.28 that included \$5.00 that was in the Navy Credit Union. These numbers did not include money that was in the ships store.

The current balance is \$3199.96. This includes \$5.00 that is in the Navy CU, \$19.12 that is in the paypal account and \$224.00 that is in a "shell" account. This account was created for last summer's reunion to help any shipmates who wanted to attend the reunion but could not afford to. None of these funds were used for this intended purpose, and so the TC Hart board decided to hold this money separate for future reunions. The money is actually in the general account, but for bookkeeping purposes it is being tracked separately. Funds that are in the ships store account are not included in this report. I recently received the following email. Can anyone provide more info on this incident?

Dear Mr. Neimeyer

I'm a Chilean journalist who is researching about an event that occurred in 1976 in Valparaiso, Chile. On September of that year, two unknown submarines were detected but these did not belong either to the Chilean Army nor to the North American Army, which was visiting Chile by the Unitas exercises.

The Chilean admiral ordained to afloat the unknown submarines with pumps depth and torpedoes, but one of the submarines could flee. Nevertheless, the destiny of the second submarine is uncertain. According to unofficial versions of the Chilean Navy, it was a Peruvian submarine that was sunk but is a secret that cannot be revealed. But there are others versions which indicate the submarine presumably sunk would be Soviet.

Recently I visited the Thomas Hart Veterans Association's webpage, and you wrote that Chilean navy ask for a suspicious contact. So, I would like to answer if you remember what happened with the unknown submarine and what is your opinion about. I'm writing, with another journalist, a book about this case.
