CRUISE BOOKS

I have obtained reproductions of the 1983 and 1986 Med deployment cruise books and the 1990-91 Desert Storm cruise book. Along with the 1975 Med and 1976 Unitas cruise books, they will be provided on the free CDs distributed to shipmates at the 2021 reunion. The reproduction cruise books along with a separate CD of each will be raffled off at the next reunion.

These high quality reproductions were obtained from DBA Classic Cruise Book Reproductions <u>www.navycruisebooks.net</u> Although the only Hart cruise books in their inventory are the 75-76-83-86-91 books, they have a large inventory from other ships. The reproductions (which include a "hard copy" and a CD) run about \$50 each, depending on the size of the book and the type cover requested. I was able to work out a credit by letting them copy the 75 and 76 books, which they did not have in their inventory. You may be able to work out a similar deal if you have books they need. I was very pleased with the speed and quality of their service.
