Nauticus is a maritime discovery center in downtown Norfolk, offering a unique form of experiential learning for all ages. Through interactive exhibits and STEM to STERN programming, Nauticus uses the museum, Battleship Wisconsin and the sailing center to tell the story of the maritime environment, industry, and the military. Waterside Park has several restaurants near the Nauticus where you can enjoy lunch before we head to the nearby Boarding Dock for the Harbor Cruise. 1:30 p.m. – Naval Base Harbor Cruise – See destroyers, submarines, and other vessels while taking in the sights of the harbor. 4:30 p.m. – Return to the hotel - Dinner and evening on your own

	(includes transportation and admission) Tour historic homes, public buildings and 18 th century craft shops where costumed hosts recreate the sights and sounds of America 200 years ago. Enjoy free time to shop and browse in the many unique specialty shops in Merchants Square. Lunch will be on your own in Colonial Williamsburg . There are plenty of dining choices to please all tastes. Experience <u>Historic Taverns</u> in the Historic Area, enjoy exquisite cuisine in <u>Modern Restaurants</u> , or check out a sandwich shop or bistro in <u>Merchants Square</u> .
Dinner and evening on your own	At Jamestown Settlement, come aboard re-creations of the three ships that brought America's first permanent English colonists to Virginia in 1607. Put yourself in the shoes of the original colonists and sailors to learn about the ships' square-rigged masts, tonnage and cargo, as well as what shipboard life was like for the first 104 men and boys. Whether on the pier or on the main deck, historical interpreters share the four-and-a-half-month voyage from England in December 1606 to Jamestown in May 1607, and periodically demonstrate knot-tying, sail-raising and 17th-century piloting and navigation.

Friday, August 25 Jo:00 a.m. – 2:00 p.m.	Tour #3 – City Narrated Tour (\$110) (Includes transportation, stop at the MacArthur, guide) Learn about Norfolk's colorful 335-year history as you enjoy a riding city tour through the lovely historic district. Many attractions include old St. Paul's Church, the Moses Myers House, MacArthur Memorial, and the Historic Freemason District. We will stop for lunch at Doumar's where you can order sandwiches off the menu (\$3.50 – \$5.25). Ice cream desserts are \$3.80 - \$7.00.
