From the Secretary

Hello shipmates,

Shipmates, I hope 2023 is treating you and yours well in all areas of your life. Reporting as the Secretary of TCHVA, I am pleased to report that the Association is robust and we are looking forward to a great reunion coming up next month. Now is the time to make those hotel reservations and get your reunion registrations completed and sent in to our reunion planner (address on the brochure). The brochure has been emailed to you in the past and it has been posted on Facebook in the TCH group a couple of times as well. I know our fabulous Newsletter editor, Dave Neimeyer, has been emailing copies to those who request one on Facebook. Here's where we are with reunion deadlines. The Association has a specified and guaranteed hotel room block BUT we must release any unbooked rooms on July 22nd so if you haven't reserved your room, you should do so ASAP because after July 22nd, our discounted rate will not be guaranteed and there may not even be any rooms available at any price.. That's enough about that. Please do not confuse July 22nd hotel deadline as a deadline for reunion registration. It is not! It is strictly about the release of unsold rooms back to the hotel. You may register for the reunion anytime up to, and including, during the reunion. While I don't recommend that as there could be issues with getting extra meals for the banquet it can be done! We will do what we can to accommodate you. It is not uncommon for a few shipmates to show up during the event.

There are only "two" requirements for you to attend the TCH reunions. First, you must be a veteran of service aboard TCH. Secondly, you must be a member of TCHVA. You may bring as many guests as you like. If you're unsure of your membership status in TCHVA you can

check the website here for a current list of members. https://thomaschart.org/tchva-member-listing/ If your name is not there, please go ahead and join/renew online or if you prefer, we'll collect your \$20 (two years dues) at the reunion when you check in.

As for the Association status, we now have 123 current paid up TCHVA members. Not bad but we could do much better. I know Facebook is convenient and a great way to communicate, but please understand that it is ONLY TCHVA that initiates, plans, coordinates, and carries out these reunions. TCHVA also funds and supports our website and helps subsidize our reunions when possible. Without our formal organization, I fear getting together for a big event would never happen. Please consider keeping your membership current. We have never raised our modest dues of \$10 annually (collected in two year increments). As long as we have your support we'll keep the cost down.
